In accordance with Section 204.3 of the Municipal Act, the City of Oshawa will be advertising for positions on the Downtown Board and will present applications to Council for appointment. The current Downtown Oshawa Board term expires on November 30, 2010. *Note ~ the City's ad will be placed at the appropriate time after the summer break by the City clerk.*

In most casts, the BIA presents a list of nominees to their general membership for a vote prior to submitting these nominees for Council approval. This practice helps ensure that the general membership is consulted on the board's composition. **Please note that nominations will be accepted and voted on at the Downtown Oshawa Board of Managements Annual General Meeting scheduled for September 8, 2010.**
